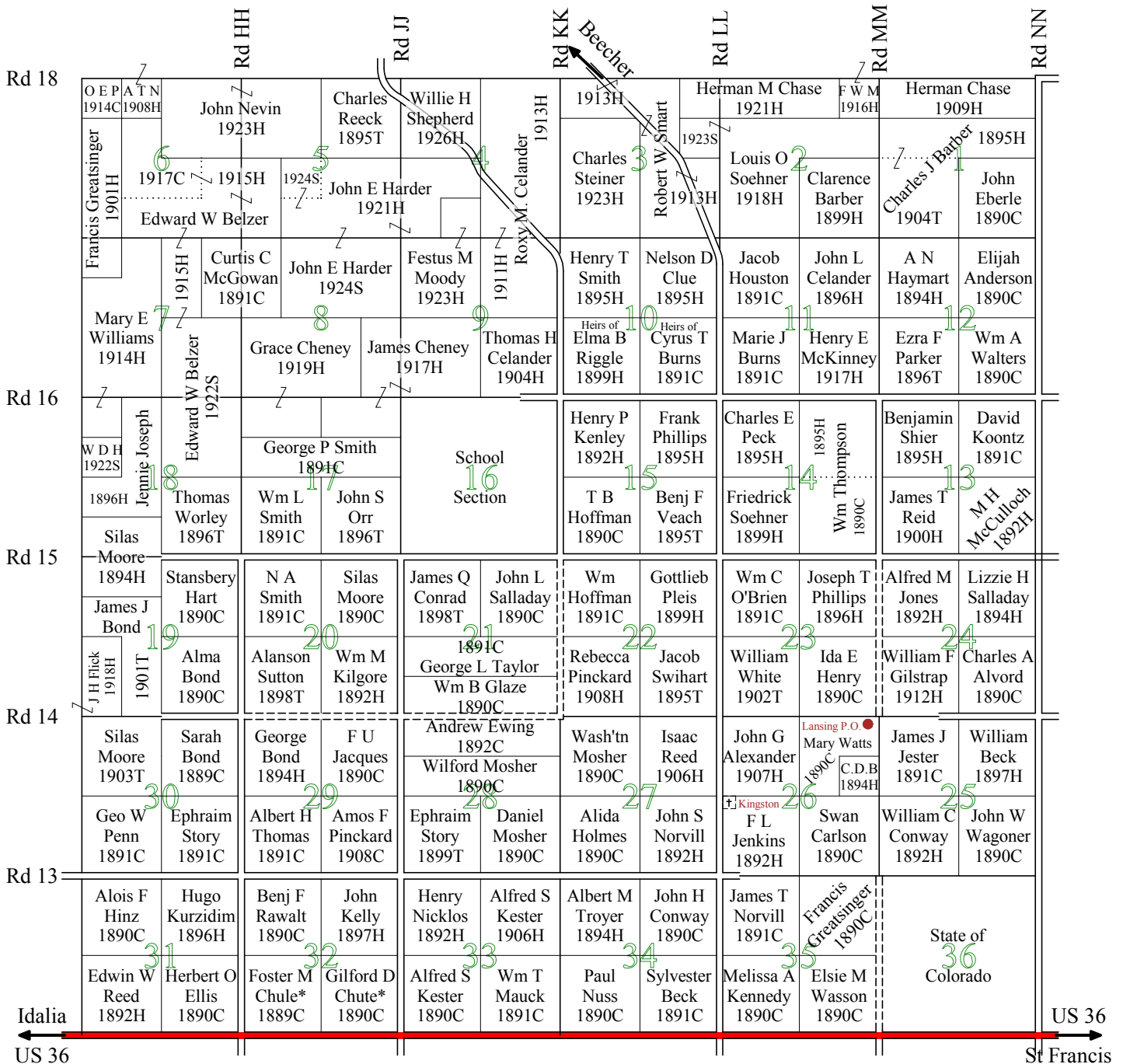

The Lansing Post Office operated from September 1886 to February 1910.

The Kingston (a.k.a. Lansing) Cemetery was established 1887.

There are several conflicts in spelling of names in the BLM General Land Office records database for this township. Friedrich Soehner is shown in the database as "Sohner". Celander is spelled as "Celander", "Calender" and "Celender" in the database. The patent transcriber also spelled "Barber" as "Barker". Foster and Gilford "Chule" or is it "Chute" or perhaps "Shule" purchased quarters next to each other in section 32.
