

## Notes:

The Mildred PO (1910-1954) was located on various farms/ranches in Sec 1 & 2 of this township for most of its 44 year life. The original 1910 location was on the Nelson Stanbrough homestead. During the time Walter Moore was postmaster, 1918-1928, it was moved across the road into Sec 7 T3S R45W where it still appears on most maps. Then the Claude Duff family took it over in 1928. When it closed in 1954 it was located in the Lotus (Duff) Wingfield home in the northeast corner of Sec 1.

The early 1870s "Robbers Roost" was located in the northwest corner in the vicinity of Sec 7.
