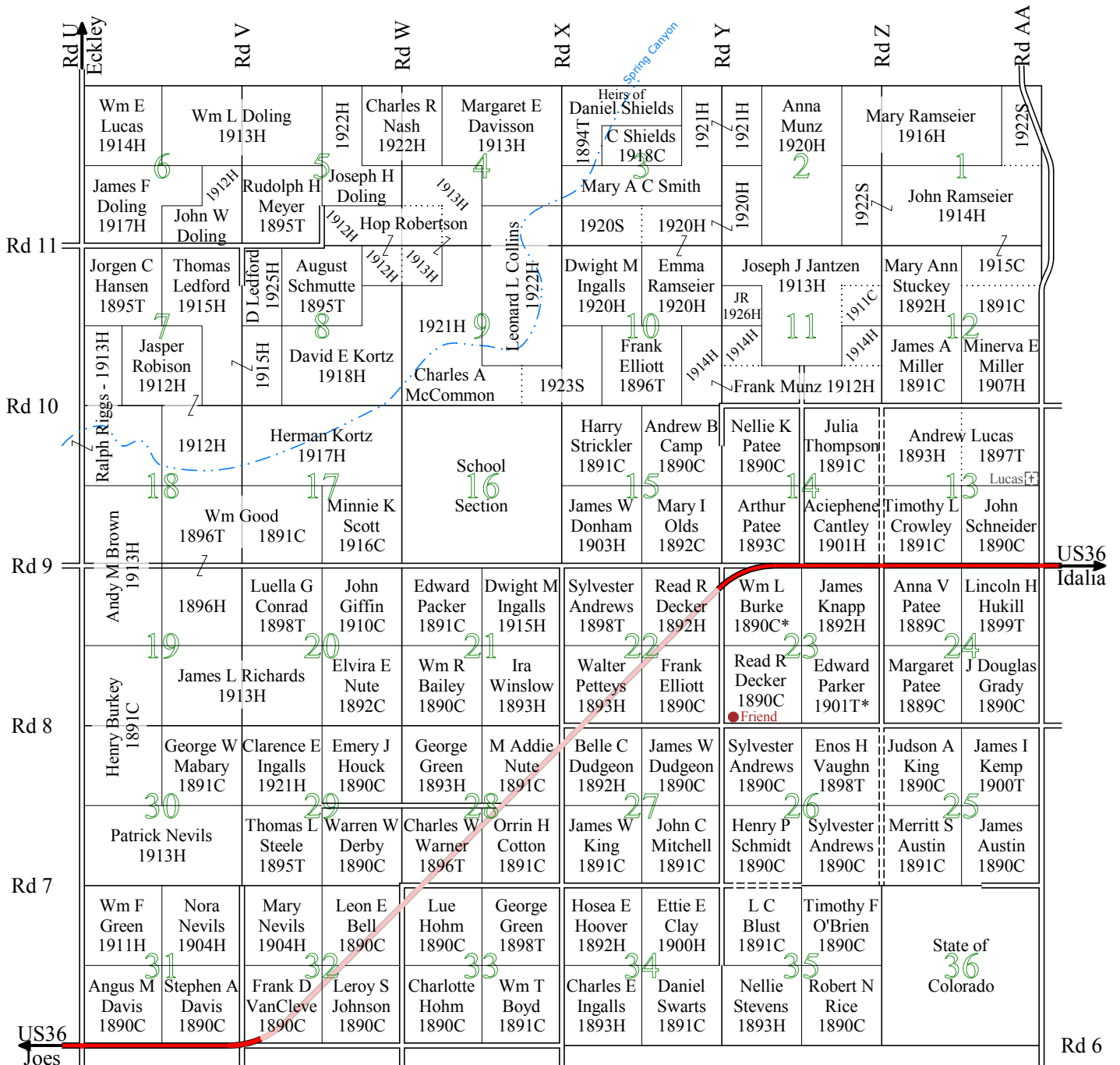

Two of the Sylvester Andrews patents (NW¼ S22 and SE¼ S26) are shown in the GLO database as "Sylvester Andrew".

Both William Burke and Edward Parker are shown in the GLO database as having patents for the NW¼ S23 while the SE¼ S23 is shown unclaimed. I tossed a coin and placed them as shown on the map. I welcome corrections!

The Friend post office opened in 1887 and closed in 1901. Friend was "the" railroad boom town of the area boasting many businesses until the mid-1890s when the railroad ended track construction at St Francis, Kansas, instead of continuing west to Limon.
